<u>If you are a Parent:</u> Scholarships are available to defray the cost for each year your child earns a Major AWANA Award. Scholarships: \$230 for Citation; \$120 for Meritorious; \$80 for Timothy.

If your camper wants to request a roommate, see application and submit by June 1st,

<u>Parent and Camper:</u> After July 1st, applications will be accepted as space and funds are available.

<u>If you are a Camper:</u> You must have been involved in a 2024-2025 Awana club. For a first-time camper be at least 11 years old by July 26<sup>th</sup>, the first day of camp; be entering Grade 6; and have completed all the AWANA handbook requirements in one T&T or higher book. For a returning camper be entering grades 7-12 or a just-graduated high school senior; and have completed all AWANA handbook requirements in one additional higher book.
